## **Outdoor Education Program Clothing & Equipment Information**

**NOTE:** We run programs (often outside) in all types of weather in every season. Please bring appropriate clothing so that you can enjoy the unique and fun opportunities available on your trip.

### **Winter (November-February)**

Winter can be great fun, but only if you are prepared. Warm clothes, hats, gloves, winter boots, long underwear, etc. make your stay much more enjoyable. Wool or synthetics (e.g. pile or fleece) work best for insulating. It is also desirable to have an outside protective layer that is water/wind resistant.

### **Spring/Fall (March-May; September-November)**

Be prepared for any type of weather. Temperatures can fall below freezing or it could be in the 70's. Please bring raingear, an extra set of clothes, and an extra pair of shoes (at least one of these should be a sturdy pair of tennis shoes). Warm clothes (see above) will be important for evening activities.

### **Summer (June-Sept)**

Weather during these months tends to be hot and humid, so cotton T-shirts and shorts work well (mid-length to knee length shorts only – “short” shorts are not recommended during activities requiring the use of a climbing harness). We would still recommend that you bring an extra set of clothes and an extra set of shoes (at least one of these should be a sturdy pair of tennis shoes). A swimsuit and towel is a necessity and it may also be a good idea to bring your own sunscreen and bug repellent (the mosquitoes can be vicious in the summer!).

### **Personal Items**

- \_ Personal hygiene items (i.e. toothbrush, toothpaste, towel, soap, etc.)
- \_ Eye glasses (an extra pair if possible)/Eye glasses strap
- \_ Camera & film (optional)
- \_ Flashlight (optional)
- \_ Sunglasses (optional)
- \_ Sun visor/Ball cap
- \_ Sleeping bag & Pillow (if linens are not provided)
- \_ Raingear (poncho, rain jacket, and/or rain pants)

### **Items NOT Allowed**

- Portable Electronics
- TV
- Knives/Firearms
- Fireworks
- Matches or Lighter
- Pets
- iPod, MP3 players, Cell Phones
