

Non-Counseling Positions

Activity Team Member:

Get to safely run activity areas for campers throughout the summer. Areas include Arts and Crafts, Skate Park, Archery, Adventure Activities and other program specific activities.

Dates: May 30 - August 10

Responsibilities include:

- Maintain the safety and proper operation of activity areas and assist campers.
- Specialize in other activities suited to their preferences and skills.
- Serve as “cabin buddies” with an overnight cabin in the evenings.

Applicants should:

- Have a proven rapport with peers and kids, commitment to excellence, and a contagious love for Christ.
- Balance fun and responsibility well.
- Have completed one year of college or be at least 19 years old by May 30.

Activity Team Member (Music specialty):

Responsibilities include the list above plus the opportunity to participate in leading worship in the Kishwauketoe, Day Camp, and/or Pier 30 programs.

Administrative Assistant:

Gets to assist with administrative tasks to help programs run smoothly for campers.

Dates: May 30 - August 10

Responsibilities include:

- Help Parent Liaison, Camp Registrar and Youth Ministry Team with camper check-in and check-out, summer budgets, camper feedback system, and other administrative tasks.
- Serve as “cabin buddies” with an overnight cabin in the evenings

Applicants should:

- Relate well to parents.
- Have good secretarial, computer and organizational skills.
- Participate in program support and plug into cabin groups.
- Be at least 18 years old by May 30.

Administrative Assistant—Day Camp:

Responsibilities include the above responsibilities, but the Day Camp Administrative Assistant will focus mainly on the Day Camp program.

Audio Tech:

Gets to run lights, video, and sound for camp programs and activities.

Dates: May 30 - August 10

Responsibilities Include:

- Coordinate with Program Directors for all AV needs.
- Participate in daily activities and build relationships with campers.
- Help in other camp programs, the camp store, and activities as needed. Serve as a “cabin buddy” in the evenings.

Applicants should:

- Have significant related experience, technical aptitude, creative abilities .
- Be at least 18 years old by May 30.

Media Tech:

Gets to take photos and video of campers for promotion and connecting parents to their child's experience.

Dates: May 30 - August 10

Responsibilities include:

- Shoot, edit and organize video and photos throughout each week.
- Create weekly highlight video for Kishwauketoe and Pier 30 programs.
- Order weekly cabin and camp photos, as well as post photos online daily for parents.
- Capture footage and organize photos for future promotional needs.
- Support programs with pre-summer video production.
- Help in other camp programs and activities as needed. Serve as a "cabin buddy" in the evenings.

Applicants should:

- Have significant related experience, technical aptitude, creative abilities, and rapport with kids.
- Be at least 18 years old by May 30.

Tech Assistant:

Gets to provide tech support to the programs along with the Media and Audio Tech.

Dates: May 30 - August 10

Responsibilities include:

- Assist the Media Tech and Audio Tech in daily responsibilities including taking photos, video, and running sound for programs.
- Participate in daily activities and build relationships with campers.
- Help in other camp programs and activities as needed. Serve as a "cabin buddy" in the evenings.

Applicants should:

- Have related experience, technical aptitude, creative abilities, and rapport with kids.
- Be at least 16 years old by May 30.

Student Nurse:

Gets to manage camper and staff health and safety throughout the summer.

Dates: May 30 - August 10

Responsibilities include:

- Work with other staff and weekly guest RN to attend to all illness and injury and refer to local doctors when necessary.
- Keep records of injuries and treatments.
- Maintain the infirmary.
- Transport campers to the clinic.
- Help in other camp programs and activities as needed.

Applicants should:

- Have a minimum of 1 year of nursing classes.
- Acquire AHA Healthcare provider CPR certification.
- Relate well and communicate effectively with campers and parents.
- Must be 21 with a valid driver's license and clean driving record.

Waterfront Team:

Gets to maintain waterfront facility and safety and operate the waterfront (including swimming area, water activities and boat driving) for campers and programs.

Dates: May 30 - August 10

Responsibilities include:

- Lifeguard.
- Drive boats.
- Maintaining all waterfront areas.
- Activity leadership.
- Assist with other program needs as necessary. Serve as a “cabin buddy” in the evenings.

Applicants should:

- Have a warm personality, physical stamina, a positive attitude, willingness to serve where needed and be prepared for a physically demanding work environment.
- Acquire current Lifeguard Training, CPR Pro Rescuer, and First Aid.
- Be at least 18 years old by May 30.

Waterfront Team/Activity Team:

Includes the above responsibilities and rotates into specific activity team roles.

Worship Leader:

Gets to coordinate worship for the Day Camp, Kishwauketoe, and Pier 30 programs throughout the summer.

Dates: May 30 - August 10

Responsibilities include:

- Coordinate with the Youth Ministry Team and Program Directors to plan and implement music and worship for all camp programs.
- Set up and maintain stage and audio equipment.
- Serve in a variety of areas including daily activity leadership.
- Assist with other program needs as necessary. Serve as a “cabin buddy” in the evenings.

Applicants should:

- Have contagious love for Jesus, sensitivity to the Holy Spirit, and the ability to lead music and singing for large groups of youth.
- Have strong accompanying skills on guitar (piano and percussion abilities are also desired).
- Have completed one year of college or be at least 19 years old by May 30.

Facilities Specialist:

Gets to work behind the scenes with year round staff members to physically care for the facility and needs of the summer program.

Dates: late-May - mid August.

Responsibilities include:

- Serving where needed.
- May include maintaining grounds with our maintenance crew.
- May include serving in the Lodge Kitchen, prepping food, monitoring the dining room, and cleaning up after meals.

Applicants should:

- Be a hard worker with a lot of initiative.
- Be at least 18 years old by start date.
