

Program Positions

Program Directors:

Will develop and implement creative, age appropriate programs for campers and lead and supervise staff.

Dates: May 22 - Aug. 11

4 positions:

- *Day Camp*—about 75 Day (8:30am-6:00pm) campers each week in 1st - 9th grade. Directors also have evening planning responsibilities and supervise high school aged counselors.
- *Kishwaukee*—about 45 overnight campers each week in 2nd - 4th grade. Directors also supervise college aged counselors.
- *Pier 30*—about 200 overnight campers each week in 4th - 9th grades. Directors supervise college aged counselors.
- *Alpha*—28 high school campers every 2 weeks. Directors supervise three Alpha counselors.

Responsibilities include:

- Program leadership (manage administrative tasks, be on stage, create fun schedules, communicate well, develop a Bible program based on yearly theme).
- Staff leadership (assist with staff training, supervise and encourage staff).
- And more.

Applicants should:

- Be passionate about leading, mentoring, and creativity.
- Have prior leadership experience.
- Balance fun and responsibility well.
- Have a proven rapport with peers and kids, commitment to excellence, and a contagious love for Christ.
- Be college seniors or graduates.

Assistant Program Directors:

Get to work with the Program Director in the development and implementation of creative and age appropriate programs and help lead staff and kids.

Dates: May 22 - Aug. 11

4 Positions:

- (2) *Day Camp*—about 75 Day (8:30am-6:00pm) campers each week in 1st - 9th grade. Assistant Program Directors also have evening planning responsibilities and help supervise high school aged counselors.
- *Kishwaukee*—about 45 overnight campers each week in 2nd - 4th grade. Assistant Program Directors also help supervise college aged counselors.
- *Pier 30*—about 200 overnight campers each week in 4th - 9th grades. Assistant Program Directors help supervise college aged counselors.

Responsibilities include:

- Program support (help develop creative programs, schedules, activities, Bible lessons, etc.).

- Administrative support (work with the Program Director on details, communication, etc.).
- Staff support (communicate well, encourage, keep them accountable).

Applicants should:

- Have prior camp staff and/or creative programming experience.
- Be willing to use administrative, communication, leadership and other gifts well.
- Have a proven rapport with kids, commitment to excellence, a servant heart and contagious love for Christ.
- Be college juniors or seniors.

Activity Team Lead:

Gets to maintain and operate a safe, fun and organized activity environment for campers and lead the Activity Team.

Dates: May 22 - Aug. 11

1 Position

Responsibilities include:

- Staff leadership (train, coordinate, supervise and care for the Activity Team).
- Facility operation and upkeep (setup activity areas, clean up after campers, restock supplies, etc.).
- Ensure camper safety via proper orientation of activity areas, managing regulation of safety equipment, etc.
- Create and run evening activities for programs.
- Assist programs with daily logistics (setting up and putting away special activities, delivering snacks etc.).

Applicants should:

- Have a passion for serving wherever necessary.
- Have previous leadership and/or activity experience.
- Be self-starters.
- Have a proven rapport with peers and kids, commitment to excellence, and a contagious love for Christ.
- Be able to balance fun and responsibility well.
- Be college juniors or seniors.

Alpha Counselors

Get to work with the Alpha Program Director to develop and implement the Alpha Bible program, daily schedule, service projects and more. Alpha Counselors also spend most of their time with high school aged campers to encourage growth in Christ through healthy relationships.

Dates: May 22 - Aug. 11

3 Positions: 1 male and 2 female

Responsibilities include:

- Assist the Program Director in development and daily implementation of Bible program, service projects and activities.
- Support Program Director with creative, administrative and organizational gifts.
- Live with, supervise and work behind the scenes alongside Alpha campers on projects and assignments.

Applicants should:

- Have a passion for mentoring, motivating, and encouraging high school students in a small community.
- Have leadership experience with high school students in a camp (or similar) environment.
- Be self-starting, flexible, organized, fun-loving, and willing to go the extra mile to make camp meaningful and exciting.
- Have a proven rapport with high school students, a servant heart and contagious love for Christ.
- Be college juniors or seniors.

Parent Liaison:

Get to work with the Youth Ministry Team and Marketing Director as an important communication link between camp and all parents.

Dates: May 22 - Aug. 11

1 Position

Responsibilities include:

- Work with appropriate staff to ensure implementation of all parental communication (Facebook updates, photo uploads, emails, e-scans, etc.) and provide quality control in said communications.
- Coordinate and ensure implementation of parent relations, check-in, check-out, follow up, lost and found and other administrative tasks.
- Train, supervise and care for the administrative assistants.

Applicants should:

- Be administratively gifted.
- Have a passion for ministering to campers and families.
- Have a proven rapport with peers and kids, commitment to excellence, and a contagious love for Christ.
- Must be 21; College senior or graduate desired.

Team Counselors:

Get to provide support, prayer, encouragement, and spiritual leadership for summer staff, and help with campers as needed.

Dates: May 22 - Aug. 11

2 Positions: 1 male, 1 female

Responsibilities Include:

- Disciple, train and evaluate counseling staff.
- Equip staff in evangelism and small group Bible study.
- Organize daily staff devotions, prayer support network and daily prayer coverage. May play role in sessions and worship leading.
- Assist counselors in providing care for campers, when needed.

Applicants Should:

- Have leadership experience (preferably with college students) and/or camp counseling experience.
- Have peer counseling and small group skills as well as communication skills.

- Have a passion to see and encourage others to grow in their faith.
- Have a proven rapport with peers and kids, commitment to excellence, and a contagious love for Christ.
- Be college seniors, graduates or seminary students.

Waterfront Supervisor and Assistant Supervisor:

Get to operate and maintain the waterfront area, manage camper safety on the waterfront, and train, lead and supervise the Waterfront Team.

Dates: May 22 - Aug. 11

2 Positions: 1 supervisor, 1 assistant supervisor

Responsibilities include:

- Staff Leadership (train, coordinate, supervise, and care for the Waterfront Team).
- Facility operation and upkeep (setup the waterfront, clean up after campers, gas boats, etc.).
- Ensure camper safety via buddy system, safe boat operation, lost swimmer drills, etc.
- Daily assist with camp programs during evenings.

Applicants should:

- Acquire current Lifeguard Training, CPR Pro Rescuer, and First Aid.
- Have a proven rapport with peers and kids, commitment to excellence, and a contagious love for Christ.
- Must be 19; College junior (assistant only), senior or graduate desired.
