

Counseling Positions

Day Camp Counseling Team:

Get to spend a majority of their time in the Day Camp program building relationships with children and families to encourage growth in Christ.

Dates: May 31 – August 9

Responsibilities include:

- Leading a small group of day campers with maturity, enthusiasm, and creativity.
- Facilitating Bible lessons.
- Managing child safety.
- Building relationships in group situations, one-on-one interaction, activity leadership, and much more.
- Helping with other camp programs and activities as needed. Serve as “cabin buddies” with an overnight cabin in the evenings.
- Applicants should:
- Be enthusiastic leaders, sensitive listeners, positive role models, and servants willing to serve where needed.
- Possess a growing and active faith in Christ and teachable heart.
- Have a love for and rapport with elementary through junior high school students.
- Be high school juniors, seniors and recent graduates, and at least 16 by May 31.

Counseling Team:

Get to spend a majority of their time with campers including activities, meal times, and overnight supervision while encouraging growth in Christ. Counselors will rotate between Pier 30 (5th-9th graders) and Kishwauketoe (2nd-4th graders) programs and may plug into the other programs as needed.

Dates: May 27 – August 9

Responsibilities Include:

- Building relationships with peers and campers.
- Assist in providing care for campers as needed.
- Managing child safety.
- Help in other camp programs and activities as needed.

Applicants Should:

- Be sensitive listeners, positive role models, servants and friends to all kids.
- Possess a mature and active faith in Christ.
- Have a love for, rapport with, and some experience interacting with elementary through junior high students especially those with special needs.
- Be willing to be flexible and be available whenever needed.
- Have completed one year of college or be at least 19 years old by May 27.
