Senior High (9-12th)

Alpha (10-12th)

discipleship, provides campers a glimpse into what it's like to work at camp and creates space for them to develop leadership, deepen faith, and foster lifelong friendships.

Day Camp (1st -6th)

Many camp favorites are packed into a condensed daily schedule of age-specific activities. Our Bible program and activity offerings change weekly, allowing campers to have a blast whether they come for one week or every week!

Kish (2nd-4th)

This introductory overnight camp program is for campers entering 2nd-4th grades. Kish campers grow in independence, learn about God, and soak up tons of play time. Two-, three- and five-night options in a small community create opportunities for campers to have a successful experience.

Pier 30 (4-9th)

This action-packed classic camp is for campers entering 4th-9th grades.
