



Student Nurse

Job Description: At Covenant Harbor, our mission is simple: **love kids and share Jesus**. One of the most important ways we do this is by providing a safe and healthy environment for campers and staff. The Student Nurse role is essential to making camp possible, without excellent medical care, we cannot welcome hundreds of children each week. We are looking for staff who have a committed and growing relationship with Jesus Christ, who are ready to serve with humility, and who want to create a fun environment where campers feel valued, safe, cared for, and encouraged to know Jesus more.

Role Overview: Student Nurses work closely with the Health Services Director and weekly onsite RNs to ensure the health, safety, and well-being of all campers and staff. This includes medication distribution, assessment and treatment of minor injuries and illnesses, documentation, and communication with program teams about medical needs.

Specific Expectations

- Live Out the Mission: Love campers wholeheartedly and point them to Jesus through your words, actions, and daily life in and outside of camp.
- Maintain Health Center Operations: Keep the infirmary clean, organized, and stocked; communicate supply needs promptly.
- Support Staff Training: Assist the Health Services Director in training summer staff on health and safety protocols.
- Provide Daily Care: Distribute camper medications, assess injuries or illnesses, and assist weekly RNs in providing medical attention.
- Document & Communicate: Keep accurate records of all medications, injuries, and medical visits; inform the Program Team of any relevant health updates.
- Assist with Check-in Procedures: Support camper medical form review, updates, and medication intake during registration.
- Assist with Emergencies: Transport campers or staff to medical facilities if directed by an RN or the Health Services Director.
- Be Present & On-Call: Attend activities and programs as scheduled to provide medical coverage.
- Collaborate: Work with other student nurses, RNs, Program Team and the Health Services Director to ensure comprehensive coverage and care throughout the summer.
- Assist Beyond Nursing: Learn to support other Nursing Team responsibilities.
- Be able and willing: Go above and beyond even your own expectations and serve wherever is needed!

Requirements

- Be at least 19 years old by the beginning of your employment at Covenant Harbor.
- Be available to live onsite at camp for staff training plus at least 7 weeks of summer camp.
- Have experience and skills with elementary, middle school, and/or high school students.
- College students seeking a degree in nursing are desired with at least one year of nursing classes.
- Valid driver's license and clean driving record required.
- Ability to pass a background check.
- Must be able to participate in potentially strenuous physical activities.
- CPR and First Aid certifications are preferred, but not required.
